MVBT Health and Safety Protocols for COVID19

For services in the NOKOTSUDO with Rev. Mukojima:

Limitation for number of attendees: **7**

Attendees must submit MVBT Health Attestation on the DAY OF the service.

- Link to online Health Attestation Form: <https://form.jotform.com/MVBT/ATT>
- Or the QR code below can be used to fill out the Health Attestation

A **Health Officer** must be identified for the service event

- The Health Officer should preferably be an MVBT member who will be attending the event
- If no MVBT member will be attending the event, then a non-MVBT member can be identified as the Health Officer.

The Health Officer is responsible for verifying that **ALL** attendees have submitted a Health Attestation on the **DAY OF** the service

- If the attendee has not submitted a Health Attestation, have the QR code available or have them fill out a paper attestation form.
- The Health Officer should give any paper attestation forms to Rev. Mukojima for the MVBT H&S Committee

Attendees should follow the below health and safety guidelines:

- All attendees must be wearing a mask
- Attendees must be fully vaccinated for COVID19 and have received booster if eligible.
- No food or drinks consumed
- Attendees who DO NOT LIVE in the SAME HOUSE should:
 - Stay at least 6 feet apart
 - Avoid holding or shaking hands, hugging, or kissing each other
 - Limit sharing items between each other

If any Attendees test positive for COVID19 within 7 days of attending the funeral, they must notify the Health Officer or MVBT at (650) 964-9426
